ENGLISH

EXPLORE

This term in Explore, students will identify ways to be healthy physically and emotionally. They will explore healthy foods, ways to be active, where you can be active, and what we can do to keep or minds health also.

This term in Maths, students will be learning about place value, learning that numbers are made up of ones and tens. They will learn about subtraction and how to use the 'friends of 10' skills to subtract numbers up to 10, and beyond, with accuracy.

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HEALTH

In Health & Wellbeing this term students will be learning about water safety around the pool, the home and other aquatic environments. Students will continue to develop their social skills as they explore how to interact with safely and towards the end of the term will be developing their understanding of road safety in time for the warmer weather and holidays.

MUSIC



This semester Prep students will attend a Music class each Monday. During Term Three they will be introduced to a variety of percussion instruments and explore and respond to the sounds they make. They will learn about pitch and rhythm through simple rhymes and songs, music games and the use of rhythm sticks.

VISUAL ART

In Term Three students will learn basic modelling techniques using a variety of materials including play dough, air dry day and plasticine. They will roll a coil, make 2D slab shapes and create a pinch pot. They will also create artworks through drawing and collage to celebrate 100 Days of Prep. The last unit of work for the term will focus on basic colour theory using paint as the students explore mixing the primary colours.
